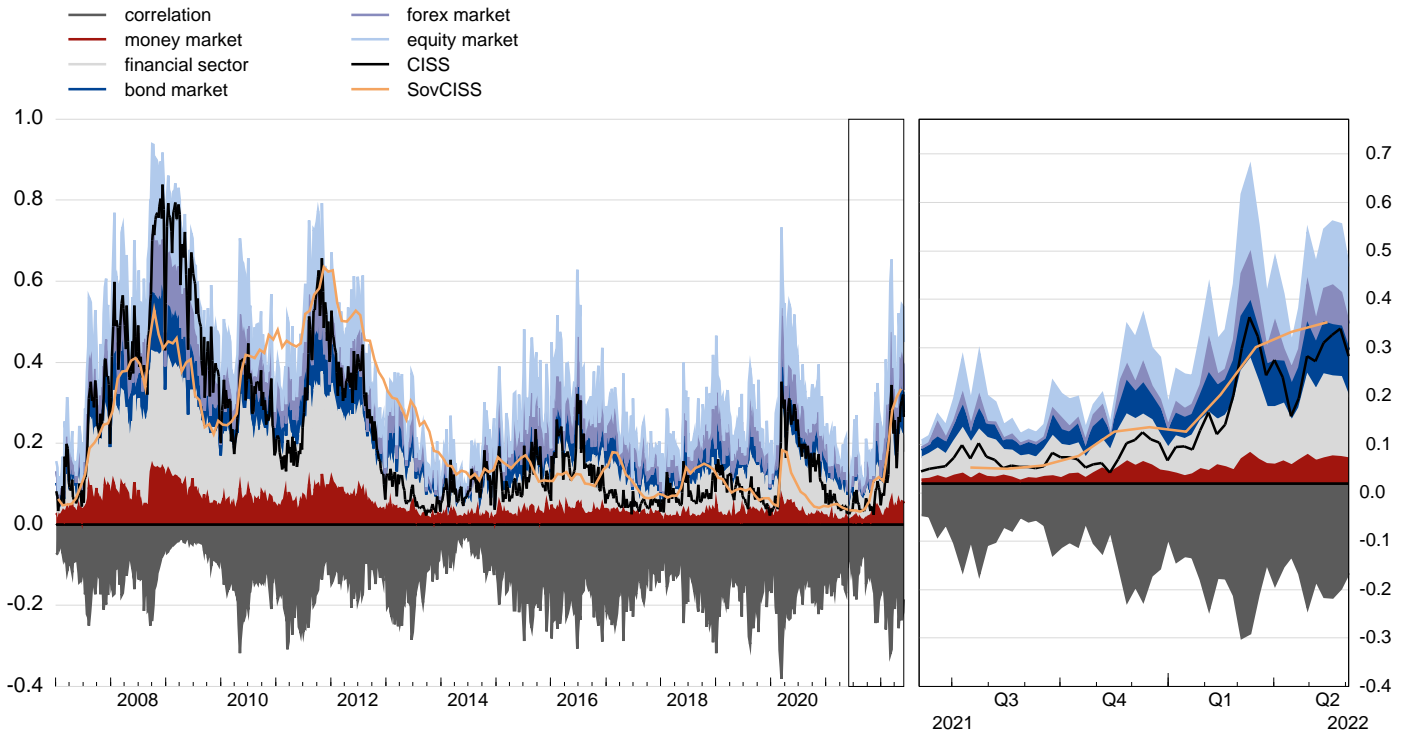


1. Interlinkages and composite measures of systemic risk

(Last observation: 3 Jun. 2022)

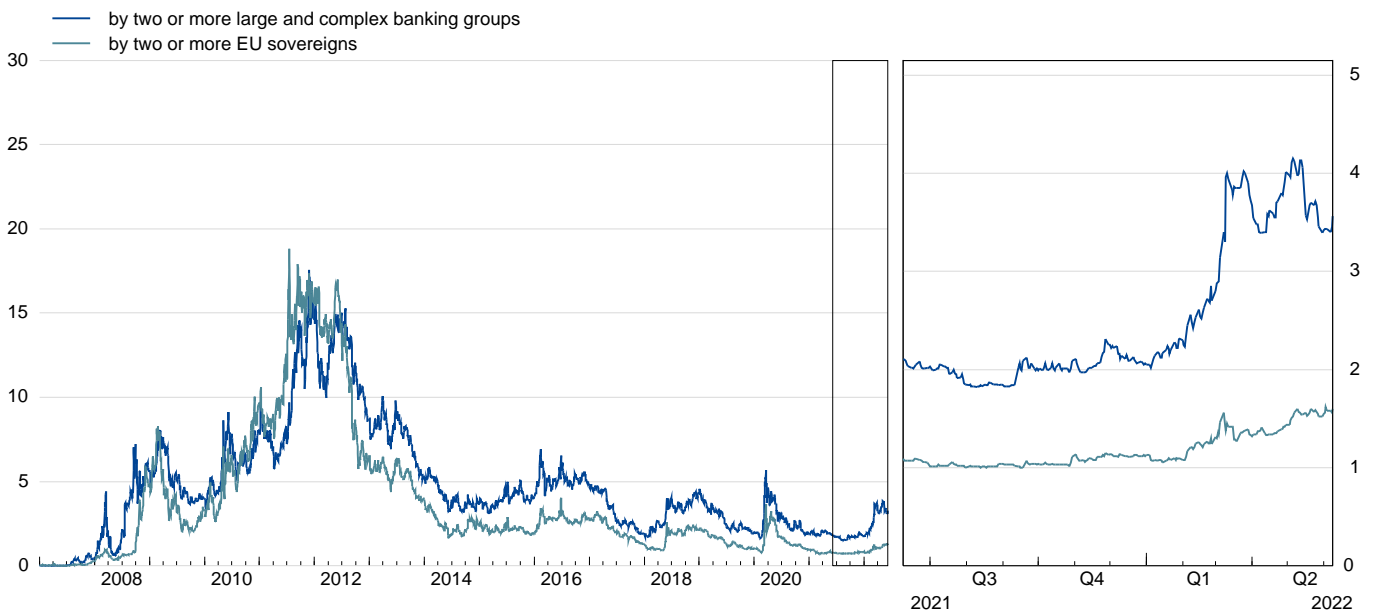
